

THE WILLOWS POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADMITTANCE

All residents and their guests must sign in. Identification in the form of a Summerlin Resident Card, driver's license or utility bill showing the Summerlin address of the resident is required. Guests are limited to one (1) per resident per visit and will only be admitted when accompanied by a resident who must accept responsibility for the actions of their guests.

SUPERVISION REQUIREMENT

Adults with minor children: To assure proper supervision, The Summerlin Council requires a minimum of one adult (sixteen years of age and older) per four children under ten years of age. Adults should be within arms length if any child is wearing a floatation device.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Only swimming apparel will be allowed in the pool. No cut-off shorts or street clothing. Babies must wear plastic pants with the elastic leg seal under a swimsuit.
- Street shoes are not allowed on the deck. Street clothing is allowed in designated areas only.
- All swimmers must shower prior to entering the water.
- Swimmers with shoulder length or longer hair must pull it back or restrain it in a swim cap.
- Only sunscreen and tanning lotions are allowed. No oils or baby oils.
- Snack food and beverages are allowed in designated areas only (grass area, shade canopy, etc.). No glass containers. No food is allowed on the pool deck.
- No smoking or alcohol is allowed within the pool enclosure.
- Persons having a skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharges, or any communicable diseases may not enter the pool area.
- No animals are allowed within the pool enclosure.
- No diving, running, dunking, pushing, cannonballing, splashing or general rough housing is allowed. No umbrellas, rafts or water toys.
- Only one person is allowed in the flume or slide at one time.
- No floaties on the big slide
- Upon exiting the flume or the slide, swimmer must proceed immediately to the nearest side of the pool. No swimming is allowed in the area of the flume or slide.
- You must proceed down the flume or slide feet first.
- No combs, bracelets, watches or jewelry is allowed on the flume, on the slide in the pool.

GENERAL

- Unsafe or offensive conduct is prohibited. Persons using obscene or profane language will be asked to leave.
- Only battery operated radios with head phones are allowed within the pool enclosure.
- The use of pool toys, floats, etc., is subject to the approval of the life guards.
- The use of personal floatation devices are subject to the approval of the life guards and are not a substitute for parental supervision.
- The pool is governed by state and local laws (NAC.444), including local health laws. In the event of any conflict between such laws and these rules, the provisions of such laws shall control to the extent they are more restrictive.

All rules are subject to change without prior notice if conditions so require.

MANAGEMENT MAY ASK ANY PERSONS IN VIOLATION OF RULES & REGULATIONS TO LEAVE THE POOL AREA.
